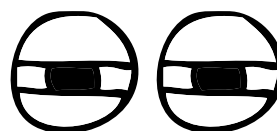

A small group of children attended the Exploring Words Festival today at the Eden Project. They spent time meeting authors, enjoying books and hearing about how the books were written and published.



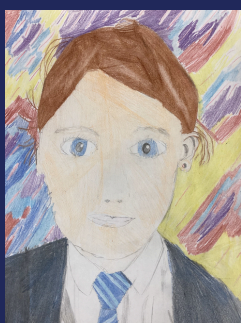
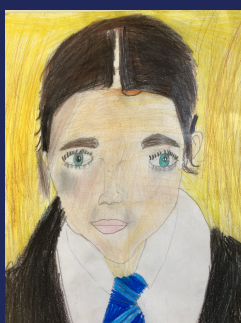

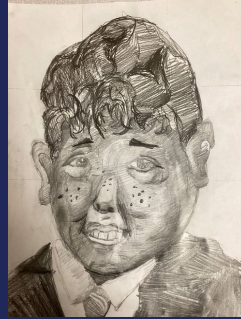
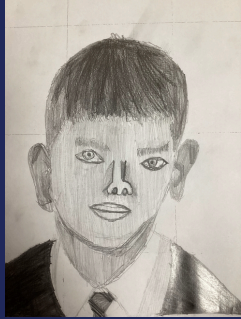
